2007 RAPIDS SEASON SUMMARY • RESUMEN DE TEMPORADA

After back-to-back appearances in the Western Conference Championship game, the Rapids expected big things in 2007. Unfortunately, a 10-game winless streak derailed Colorado's bid to reach the playoffs for a sixth straight year. Fernando Clavijo's squad made it close as they entered the final weekend of the season with the playoffs still within reach.

The season began with the opening of Dick's Sporting Goods Park and Herculez Gomez christened the new stadium with a goal 19 minutes into his debut as a member of the Rapids. Colorado would go on to win the game 2-1 and would start the season 4-2-3, challenging for the lead in the Western Conference.

Starting with a three-game road trip, Colorado was unable to win a game in the months of June and July. The team picked up ties at Chicago and at Kansas City and battle to a draw with Columbus in front of a packed house on the Fourth of July.

August saw a turn around for the squad as they earned full points from a three-game home stand to close out the month. During this stretch they defeated both MLS Cup finalists, Houston (1-0) and New England (3-0), and the David Beckham-less LA Galaxy in a game that saw Conor Casey, Colin Clark and Mike Petke score their first goals with the Rapids.

September produced another disappointing record 0-2-3 and Colorado entered the final month of the season needing three wins in three games and some help from around the league. The Rapids avenged an early season loss at Toronto by beating the expansion franchise 1-0. The next weekend, Colorado traveled to take on the Western Conference leaders, Chivas USA. Ugo Ihemelu put the Rapids ahead, but Orlando Perez equalized in the 78th minute. Colorado wasn't done yet as Casey fought off defenders and took a Coundoul punt to the end line before slotting a perfect pass to Omar Cummings for the game winner.

The Rapids returned home for the final game of the regular season. A couple of missed chances in the first half had the team pressing for a goal and victory to keep them in the playoff hunt. The goal would not come and Real Salt Lake took advantage to win the game and the Rocky Mountain Cup, ending the Rapids season.



The 2007 season saw the opening of the Rapids' new home, Dick's Sporting Goods Park. La estación 2007 consideró la apertura del nuevo hogar de los Rapids, Dick's Sporting Goods Park.

Luego de apariciones consecutivas en el juego del campeonato Western Conference, los Rapids esperaban un gran año 2007. Lamentablemente, una racha de diez juegos sin victorias descarriló las esperanzas de Colorado de alcanzar la final por sexto año consecutivo. El equipo de Fernando Clavijo estuvo cerca en el último fin de semana de la temporada cuando la final todavía estaba a su alcance.

La temporada comenzó con la inauguración del Dick's Sporting Goods Park con un partido en el que Herculez Gómez bautizó el

nuevo estadio con un gol a los 19 minutos, en su debut como miembro de los Rapids. Colorado ganaría el juego 2 a 1 y comenzaría la temporada 4-2-3, como retador del liderazgo en la Western Conference.

Colorado comenzó como visitante en tres juegos y no ganó ninguno en los meses de junio y julio. El equipo logró empates en Chicago y Kansas City y, con dificultad, logró empatar en Columbus con el estadio lleno el 4 de julio.

En agosto la suerte del equipo cambiaría al obtener puntos completos en tres partidos como local casi al final del mes. En este punto, vencieron a los dos finalistas de la MLS Cup, Houston (1-0) y New England (3-0), así como a los LA Galaxy sin David Beckham en un juego en el que Conor Casey, Colin Clark y Mike Petke anotaron sus primeros goles con los Rapids.

En septiembre hubo otro puntaje decepcionante 0-2-3 y Colorado entró al último mes de la temporada con la necesidad de tres victorias en tres juegos y algo de ayuda de la liga. Los Rapids superaron las pérdidas del comienzo de la temporada en Toronto venciendo a la franquicia expandida 1 a 0. El siguiente fin de semana, Colorado viajó a enfrentarse a los líderes del Western Conference, Chivas USA. Ugo Ihemelu puso a los Rapids a la cabeza, pero Orlando Pérez empató en el minuto 78. Colorado no había terminado aún, pues Casey se enfrentó a los defensas y llevó el puntapié de Coundoul a la línea de meta antes de hacerle un pase perfecto a Omar Cummings y ganar el juego.

Los Rapids regresaron a casa para el juego final de la temporada regular. Debido a un par de oportunidades perdidas en el primer tiempo, el equipo debió buscar el gol y la victoria para poder continuar en la lucha y llegar a la final. No hubo tal gol y Real Salt Lake aprovechó para ganar el juego y la Rocky Mountain Cup. Así terminó la temporada de los Rapids.
